PMD



PLASTIC PACKAGING



Common packaging in the horeca.



Films and bags smaller than 1m² and buckets smaller than 8 litres.



METAL PACKAGING



DRINK CARTONS



Rules for proper recycling



Empty packaging completely.



Do not put items inside one another.



Don't tie small bags filled with PMD.

What is not allowed in the PMD



Gas cylinders, batteries and electr(on)ical appliances.



Packaging > 8 litres.



Other items.



Packaging featuring one of these **pictograms** and/or **packaging with child-resistant fastenings**.



ACUTE TOXICITY (GHS06)



CHRONIC TOXICITY (GHS08)



Industrial films, pallet covers and bags larger than 1 m².



Packaging made of a **combination of materials** (e.g. plastic film layer + aluminium film layer) which cannot be separated, like some bag-in-box packagings and coffee packagings.
